GOLD DRILLING COMMENCES AT EMU LAKE

- Aircore drilling underway at Emu Lake Project
- Drilling to test surface gold anomalies for bedrock-hosted gold

Metal Hawk Limited (**ASX: MHK**, "Metal Hawk" or "The Company") is pleased to advise that aircore drilling is underway at the Company's Emu Lake Project. The program consists of several aircore traverses designed to test surface geochemical gold anomalies for bedrock hosted mineralisation.

Metal Hawk's Managing Director Will Belbin commented: "These standout gold targets at Emu Lake have not had any previous drilling. We are very excited to kick off our maiden gold exploration program and see great potential for new discoveries on this quality project."




Figure 2. Emu Lake and Kanowna East Project locations

Exploration Drilling Commences




Figure 3. Aircore drilling planned at Emu Lake showing magnetics (greyscale) and gold geochemistry (yellow 10ppb Au, Red 20ppb Au, Magenta 50ppb Au)

The Emu Lake Project is located only 75 kilometres from Kalgoorlie and situated along the Gindalbie greenstone belt (Figure 2). There are a number of surface gold anomalies on this trend which Metal Hawk will be drill-testing over the next few weeks (Figure 3).

While the Company is focused on exploring for gold at Emu Lake, the project is also highly prospective for nickel sulphides. Metal Hawk has a Farm-in and Joint Venture Agreement with Western Areas Limited (ASX: WSA) which includes the Emu Lake Project. WSA can earn a joint venture interest in all commodities other than gold and are managing nickel exploration on the project.

About Metal Hawk Limited

Metal Hawk Limited is a Western Australian mineral exploration company focused on early stage discovery of gold and nickel sulphides. Metal Hawk holds interests in a number of quality projects in the Eastern Goldfields and the Albany Fraser regions.

Metal Hawk recently signed an Earn-In and Joint Venture Agreement with Western Areas Limited (ASX: WSA) whereby WSA have the right to earn a 75% interest in three of MHK's projects; Kanowna East, Emu Lake and Fraser South by spending \$7.0 million over 5 years. Metal Hawk is free carried to decision to mine and retains gold rights at the Kanowna East and Emu Lake Projects.

In September 2019, Metal Hawk signed an Option and Earn-in Agreement with Chalice Gold Mines Limited (ASX: CHN) under which CHN can earn up to 70% of the Viking Gold project by spending \$2.75 million on exploration over 4.5 years.




Figure 4. Metal Hawk project locations
